- **Planned / likely discharges**
- **Outliers / repatriations**
- **Planned admissions**
- **Planned procedures (e.g. theatre / CT / MRI etc)**
- **Planned teaching / meetings / Video Conference?**
- **Any patients suitable for trial recruitment?**
